In partnership with the Cambridge University, Cambridge English Course is offered to improve the language of the students. The Assessment Exams are conducted at the end of every year and grade certificates are issued to our learners.

Moreover, this year around 100 students of our school have taken Online STEP ENGLISH OLYMPIAD test. A new venture to make our students to be familiar with the continuous changes in technology
